

***ABOUT ASHA
AND THE GRANT:***

The mission of ASHA is to protect and promote the health of children and youth by supporting coordinated school health programs as a foundation for school success. Through the Student Research Grants Program, ASHA provides financial support for students to complete research in areas related to our mission. Acceptance of a grant carries with it an obligation to submit a satisfactory report for publication by the editor of any ASHA publication or presentation at an ASHA conference.

ELIGIBILITY:

All student members of ASHA are eligible to apply. Simultaneous membership and proposal submission is acceptable. Grants may be awarded annually to undergraduate or graduate students.

***PREPARATION
OF PROPOSALS:***

Proposals must be developed using the following proposal format and a copy of the cover sheet must constitute the first page of the proposal. The narrative should constitute the major portion of the proposal and an itemized budget must make up the final section of the proposal. The proposal is limited to no more than five pages including the cover page and budget. Please remove all personal and institutional identifiers from the proposal narrative and budget.

The proposal must include the following:

1. Cover Sheet: Use the form provided.
2. Narrative: Should include the following:
 - a) Title-problem, hypothesis or research equation
 - b) Review of pertinent literature
 - c) Research design and methodology
 - d) Data analysis and reporting
 - e) Institution IRB protocol documented
3. Budget: Itemized list of supplies, materials and equipment/service needed.
4. The proposal shall have one-inch margins, be double-spaced, and use a font size no smaller than 12.
